

## JUNEE TO MOSS VALE RAIL GRINDING November 2021

Starting Sunday, 14 November

### Rail Grinding Works

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) continually operates track machines across the network to improve rail track conditions and allow safer and more reliable and quieter rail operations.

We will be carrying out around the clock rail grinding work **between Junee and Moss Vale from 14 November through to 29 November 2021**. The work is scheduled as follows:

**Junee to Cootamundra 14 – 15 November 2021**

**Goulburn to Moss Vale 15 – 29 November 2021**

This work will be completed in periods when fewer trains operate allowing the work to be undertaken safely and efficiently, meaning that **some work will be completed at night**.

The rail grinding machine will be stabled for essential maintenance during these periods in sidings at **Junee, Cootamundra, Goulburn, Marulan, Bundanoon and Moss Vale**. While this maintenance is being completed **the engine will continue running** to power the required equipment.

### How could this work affect you?

These works are likely to be noisy as the rail grinding machine will remain idling during maintenance. This allows us to check that all the components of the machine are operating correctly. To mitigate noise, we will stable at a location away from homes and buildings where possible.

We will be working hard to minimise any disruptions this work may cause, and we appreciate your patience and understanding while this important work is completed.
