

Commencing Tuesday, 20 June

Track machine operation and maintenance

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) continually operates track machines across the network to improve track conditions and allow safer, more reliable, and quieter rail operations.

We will be completing rail grinding work across **Victoria** from **Serviceton to Melbourne** between the hours of **6:00am until 6:00pm daily** from **Tuesday 20 June** and continuing through until **Friday 23 June 2023**.

The rail grinding machine will be stabled for essential maintenance **overnight** at **Horsham, Maroona, Inverleigh, and Gheringhap** during this period. While this maintenance is being completed the **engine will continue running** to power the required equipment.

How could this work affect you?

While the machine is completing grinding work the noise impact will be minimal and the machine should pass by reasonably quickly. It **will be noisy during overnight machine maintenance** as the engine will be left running to allow us to check that all the components of the machine are operating correctly. We will stable away from homes and buildings where possible, however some residents will be impacted.

The movement of materials and machinery may result in the generation of dust. We will take practical measures to reduce the amount of dust produced by our works where possible.

Traffic controllers and temporary signage will safely guide all road users around any changed traffic conditions. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of the traffic controllers and signs

We will be working hard to minimise any disruptions this work may cause, and we appreciate your patience and understanding while this important work is completed.
