Introduction

Signallers must use this checklist when authorising an unsignalled rail traffic movement within the yard limits of a consolidated yard.

The Signaller must make sure that all necessary assurances are gained and recorded before giving spoken authority for the unsignalled movement.

Mandatory items

All items must be completed:

- 1. Number
- 2. An unsignalled movement within yard limits is required because
- 3. The unsignalled movement is authorised
- 4. Assurances
- 5. Movement authorised by Signaller

Completing Item 2 - An unsignalled movement within yard limits is required because

Give brief and clear details about why the unsignalled movement has to be made.

Completing Item 3 - The unsignalled movement is authorised

Give clear details of the limits of the movement as the signal numbers and/or locations and/or kilometrages.

Completing Item 4 - Assurances
