Essential railway maintenance works – Stroud Road to Coffs Harbour

The Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) advises that we will be carrying out essential rail maintenance and improvement works as part of a scheduled track possession in the **Stroud Road to Coffs Harbour** area from **6:00pm Friday 22 October 2021 – 6:00pm Sunday 31 October 2021 6:00pm including overnight work.**

Throughout the possession there will be traffic impacts, it will be noisy at times, some dust may be generated, and light towers will be required for night work. Please be assured that we will implement measures to manage and minimize these impacts on the community as much as possible.

Some mobilisation works will take place in the days before the possession. During this time, you may notice an increase in the presence of railway workers, vehicles, plant, equipment and materials in your area. The majority of mobilisation works are proposed to be completed within standard hours, but some locations may require night work.

Some post possession works will also be undertaken as sites are tidied and plant, equipment and materials are taken away. Activity during this period is to be completed within standard work hours.

Traffic controllers and temporary signage will safely guide all road users around any changed traffic conditions. We expect no increase to overall travel times. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of the traffic controllers and signs.

The safety of our staff and communities is our top priority and there will be a range of measures in place to manage the risk of Covid-19. This is a responsibility ARTC takes seriously, and we are working hard to ensure we balance the challenge of ensuring the safety and reliability of a critical transport network, alongside our obligations to meet and respond to the current public health challenges associated with Covid-19. We are committed to adhering to the NSW Government guidelines and where practicable we will implement additional control measures.
