Very High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has a clear link to causal factors and will prevent fatality. • Addresses legislative gap.
High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has a clear link to causal factors and will prevent or reduce serious injury. • Benefits will be closely related to a critical or strategic risk.
Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has a clear link to a contributing factor and will prevent or reduce injuries. • Benefits will have some link to a critical or strategic risk.
Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • System enhancers that do not have a direct impact on causal factors
