Upcoming rail works in your area

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be carrying out essential track maintenance and improvement works on the north east rail line at several locations **between Seymour and Wodonga from 6:00am to 6:00pm daily from Saturday 12 March until Monday 14 March 2022**. There will be no night work during this period.

We will begin mobilising to sites and carrying out minor preparation work in the days prior to the maintenance work commencing. Site clean-up will commence following the maintenance work and will be completed during standard construction hours.

How could this work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery, vehicles and plant which will generate some noise. We will turn off machinery when not in use, arrange work in stages and/or phase the equipment used at one time to reduce noise impacts where possible.

Temporary signage will safely guide all road users around any changed traffic conditions. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of the traffic controllers and signs where appropriate.

There may be traffic delays as some level crossings may be activated for longer than usual duration.

The movement of materials and machinery on site may result in the generation of dust. We will take practical measures to reduce the amount of dust produced by our works where possible.

ARTC would like to remind the community to take extra care around rail works and level crossings and we thank you for your patience and understanding while these important works are being undertaken.
