## **General Details / Operating Condition:**

A Waiver to the conditions of the Route Access Standard (RAS) is issued for a wired distributed power (WDP) coal train trial from Tahmoor via Moss Vale to Unanderra.

Operating conditions during the test shall be as follows:

- 1. The train shall consist of up to 44 individual wagons.
- 2. Allowable wagons and loading: QHAH / QHBH coal hoppers are permitted to be **loaded to a maximum of 100T** gross vehicle mass.
- 3. Locomotives used for the trial are 6000, 6020, ACD & CF class permitted to operate in distributed power configuration Loco 44 x QHAH / QHBH wagons Loco.
- 4. There shall be no mixing of empty and loaded (or part loaded) wagons in the consist
- 5. The train shall be operating in ECP and WDP mode.
- 6. WDP operation shall be in synchronous mode only.
- 7. Routine ECP/WDP functionality testing shall be carried out prior to service.
- 8. The use of dynamic brake (DB) when the remote locomotive is idle or dead attached shall be prohibited.
- 9. Aurizon will have a recovery plan in place in the event of a train failure during this trial.
- 10. Between Tahmoor and Summit Tank the published section speeds shall be adhered.

## Specific Operating Conditions for the Summit Tank to Port Kembla route

- 11. The use of DB is permitted and the descent speed from Summit Tank to Unanderra shall not exceed 25 km/h.
- 12. The train shall be brought to a stand if the train speed exceeds 30 km/h or more than 50% of train brake command (TBC) is required to hold train speed.
