

Engineering and Project Management Updates

1. ARTC ENGINEERING AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT REASSESSMENTS

Over the course of the next 12 months, a number of engineering and project management roles will commence coming up for re-assessment.

Engineering and Project Management Role Re-assessments

As per the ARTC document PER-PEO-008 Engineering Design and Project Management procedure, roles are to be re-assessed every 4 years from the original application date to show continued currency of skills and knowledge. This is achieved by uploading current evidence of continued experience in the chosen roles.

External Assessor Re-assessments

Further to this, external assessors currently approved to carry out assessments on behalf of ARTC for both their own companies and external organisations will also require re-assessment, every 4 years from the original application date to show continued currency of skills and knowledge. This is also achieved by uploading current evidence of continued experience in the assessor role and a re-signed assessor agreement. This will include uploading:

- A current signed copy of the assessor agreement;
- Part B of the Record of Relevant Experience, and
- A copy of an assessment carried out in the last 12 months will also need to be supplied

2. John Holland and ARTC Mutual Recognition

Recent discussions between John Holland Rail and ARTC have led to an agreement between both organisations to recognise the engineering and project management roles and associated assessment processes.

What does this mean:

This means that as of September 1 2017, should an engineer hold an active ARTC – Designer (Civil) role for example, this role will also be recognised by John Holland Rail, and the engineer will not need to apply again under the John Holland assessment application process. From a mutual recognition perspective, ARTC will also recognise the like John Holland engineering and project management role.

3. Changes to the Onsite Assessment Portal

In the interest of simplifying evidence upload requirements to the Onsite Assessment portal, separate pieces of evidence per question will not be required. These have been removed and consolidated into the “record of relevant experience’ and associated documentation will be assessed accordingly.

Reminder for External Assessors

Ensure expiry dates are being captured in Onsite for assessments carried out. This allows for more accurate reporting and indicates to all parties involved that action is required come the due date.
