RIDING ON ROLLING STOCK

A Rail Industry Safety Notice (RISN No. 20) is attached to this Safety Alert

This Notice is a reminder that current Prohibitions still exist in relation to “riding on rolling stock”

This notice particularly applies to:

- **Ballast Trains** – *(please note – Work Method Statement (WMS) TRA-027 has been updated. A training package on unloading ballast trains is available - contact D Snowden – 0418 229 339)*
- Rail-sets
- Sleeper laying machinery
- “On track” machinery (for example, Tampers, Regulators)

WHAT IS REQUIRED

- Print out RISN No. 20 and the Prohibition Notice
- Please discuss with all employees under your control, the requirements of the Prohibition Notice and what it means.
- Ensure a “sign-off” (for example, a Team Safety Meeting record) is obtained to verify that employees have been briefed on the Prohibition Notice.
- Ongoing vigilance to ensure that the conditions of this Prohibition Notice are adhered to – no “short-cuts”
