MID-NORTH COAST FLOODING

Severe flooding on the Mid-North Coast of NSW has resulted in washaways of rail ballast and the forced closure of the rail line between Kempsey and Casino.

An inspection of the rail corridor this morning has established that due to continual rain, along with already identified wash-a-ways and land slides it is forecast that train movements will not recommence until approximately 1800 hours tomorrow.

Track restorations and repairs in the affected areas between Casino and Kempsey are currently underway.
